TASTING NOTES

Bandit Rosé is a delicate Syrah-based blend with a lovely pale pink hue. Aromas of white peach and apricot set the stage for a flavorful palate of strawberries and tart cranberries. This wine's crisp acidity makes it a refreshing pairing for light summer salads or grilled seafood.

WINE MAKING NOTES

The Syrah and Merlot grapes were gently pressed with minimal color extraction from the grape skins, ensuring a delicate hue in this rosé. The grapes were fermented at cool temperatures in stainless steel tanks to preserve their bright acidity and fresh fruit character. The resulting wine is medium-bodied with a crisp, fruit-filled palate.
